 This packet contains Setup, Check-in and Teardown information for OUTDOORS VENDORS (Rows L, M, N, P, Q, R and T, K4).

- Left on Arlington (East direction)
- Enter the OC Fair & Event Center at Gate 4

Friday Oct 18th is the official setup date.

We have about 200 vendors! Please follow these procedures for an easy flow.

<p>WHAT TO BRING</p>	<p>Dollies/cart Extension Cords</p>
<p>CHECK-IN Please check-in on the side of the fence area.</p>	<p>Rows K ~ R : As you enter the one way system, a volunteer will check you in and give you a vendor package You can drive in & unload your things at your booth space.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Pick up your envelope at the check in table (2) Keep driving in – one way system (1 way IN and 1 way OUT) (3) A volunteer will guide you along the way to your booth (4) Unload time = 20 mins MAX. A volunteer will direct you to your assigned area, where to park and unload (5) Volunteers will be wearing GREEN-colored t-shirts with the "SoCal VegFest" logo. They will help guide you to the right location. SCVF Staff will be wearing PURPLE-colored t-shirts.

	(6) ALL vehicles must be OFF the grounds by 7PM on Friday night. Please plan accordingly.
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General Guidelines:

- Food Vendors: **DO NOT** bring any food on Friday to set up at your booth unless you have previously bought food storage space with SCVF.
- We will provide a refrigeration truck for prepackaged food items for an extra fee of \$130/pallet size. Please contact us asap if this service is needed. Space is very Limited!
- OUTDOOR vendors: You are responsible for providing your own canopy. You must use sandbags and/or concrete blocks to hold down the tent legs in case of wind.
- All Restaurant vendors are REQUIRED to provide two 5 dollar items.

SETUP TIME	<p>Saturday Setup begins AT 7:00 A.M for Food trucks and restaurant vendors.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Bring Food/beverage for the day. (2) You must be fully setup for the health inspection by 9:00 A.M. We have about 100 food booths for inspection. It will be a very busy morning for health inspectors. IF you are not ready for the inspection <u>by 9:00 am</u>, the health inspector will not be able to circle back to approve your booth until all other booths that are ready are inspected first. Hence, you may not be able to open until after the festival starts. Please keep in mind, SoCal VegFest is NOT responsible for any tardiness. <p>Sunday Setup begins at 9:00AM.</p>
PARKING (see Map for Parking)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Festival Asphalt/Campground parking will be closed to access by 9am on Saturday morning. This space do get filled up fast in early morning. • By 10am on both Saturday and Sunday, ALL cars need to be OFF the festival site. Fences will be closed up by 10am. • You must have a Parking Hangtag in order to park in the vendor parking lot (Festival Asphalt, Campground + LOT E) • The gate to regular vendor parking area (Festival Asphalt/Campground) will be closed down by 11am due to full parking. All Overflow vendors will be guided to park in Lot E. • Your personal vehicle needs to be OFF the festival site by 10am. • If you didn't park in a stall in the Festival Grounds (vendor parking lot), you are required to move your car or get towed.

<p>PARKING (see Map for Parking) con't</p>	<p>Once Festival Grounds parking is filled up, you will need to park in LOT E & F (attendee parking lot). So please make sure that you park in a stall EARLY on!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO parking in the firelanes/sidewalk.
<p>FOODTRUCK CHECK-IN Please check-in on the side of the fence area.</p>	<p>Foodtrucks - please come Check-In before 8am. The Event Venue Staff will close the gates to the Vendor Parking lot by 9am and will NOT let you in without the vendor parking passes.</p>
<p>Your Required Handwashing Stations</p>	<p>Insulated Water Handwashing Stations: You will need to provide your own 5-gallon insulated container with warm water (~100 degrees) for hand-washing purposes ONLY. You must bring your own catch bucket, soap dispenser and paper towels.</p> <p>We will begin to fill up the igloos with hot water as early as 7:15 am (see 2 RED Circles on map for fast hot water fill up areas)</p>
<p>OPEN FOOD VENDORS (TFFII/Cat.2)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) YOU will have access to a 3 compartment sink - Provided by SCVF - please see map for your assigned sinks (2) If your booth is in rows N, P, and R you are on the dirt/grass outdoors, you must bring a fire-retardant tarp for your open food vendor booth space. (3) PLEASE bring your own K1 Fire Extinguisher. (4) Open flame cooking with propane needs to have a crate. (5) Open flame cooking: There must be a 20ft fire lane clearance between the back of your booth (from prep tent) to the open flame cooking area.
<p>ELECTRICITY</p>	<p>If you have purchased electricity, please bring at least a 50ft-100ft extension cord. We do not provide extension cords.</p>
<p>TFF CHECKLISTS</p>	<p>Please check here to download your checklist for your booth: Prepackaged 1A, 1B Category 2</p>
<p>VENDOR STAFF EXIT + RE-ENTERING FESTIVAL</p>	<p>Before 10am on Sat/Sun: You and your staff can reenter/exit as needed from all doors.</p> <p>After 10am on Sat/Sun: You and your staff member can only reenter/exit (with presence of your vendor badge) at 3 Blue Stars(see map).</p>

SECURITY	You can leave your setup overnight. We have overnight security on-site Friday and Saturday. The outdoor space is fenced off, and the indoor space will be locked. SCVF is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
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Remember that all food items need to be vegan! As a reminder: HONEY and BEESWAX are not vegan.

DO NOT BRING NON-VEGAN ITEMS. You will be removed from the festival without recourse. We take this very seriously.

BOOTHS & BANNERS

- Each FOOD Booth must have your company name, booth number, address of your food facility and food symbols (common food allergens) written and displayed on your booth and be at least 3 inches tall in font. Banners are recommended.
*Please note: SCVF does not provide Banners.
- You must bring your own food pictures, banners and signs. All signs/pictures should be large enough to be visible from a distance of 15+ft away.
- You will receive a small food allergen poster from us - displaying common food allergy ingredients in your food/samples based upon the information provided by you on your application. **Outdoor vendors: Affix this poster to the right side of your tent, pole or food truck.** Be prepared to show a full ingredients list for your attendees. SCVF DOES NOT PROVIDE THIS.
- FOOD Vendors: Your menus (food allergen forms that you have submitted) will also be displayed at our INFO Booths to help the attendees get to you.

DURING THE FESTIVAL	
ANY ISSUES:	Please report to the VEGFEST OFFICE! Your needs will be taken in the order received
VENDOR STAFF exit/re-entering festival:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before 10am on Sat/Sun: You and your staff can reenter/exit as needed from all doors. • After 10am on Sat/Sun: You and your staff member can only reenter/exit (WITH the presence of your vendor badge) at 3 Blue Stars (see map).
ICE	You can buy ice \$10 for 20lb at VEGFEST OFFICE
FOOD WASTES	Please do NOT dispose your food wastes in the 3 compartment sinks. There will be trash cans provided next to the sinks throw those away so we can compost them.

DELIVERIES for you FROM OUTSIDE OF VEGFEST	Additional deliveries: SCVF staff must be informed of the scheduled deliveries during the event time so we can let the venue staff know if a drop off can be made.

CLEAN UP	Please clean up your booth area before you exit the premises.
FOOD VOUCHERS	Restaurant Vendors: Please turn in your Food Vouchers at the VegFest Office. You will be reimbursed within 15 days of the festival.
FOODTRUCKS	May NOT leave without venue security clearance of the attendees which is usually around 6:30pm.
